



Grocery Card Program: Let's Help Moorcroft Food Pantry!

Kick-Off April 28 ~ 11:10 am

in the Fellowship Hall

Moorcroft is in the middle of a "food desert" in northeast Wyoming.

- Rev. Monte Reichenberg, Moorcroft Presbyterian Church, is president of the Pantry Board.
- Our Irmgard Meyer grant of \$20,000 helped the pantry stay open for two months.
- Over 22% of area residents are on a fixed income; with inflation, the need for help is extreme.
- The pantry serves 1,800-2,000 children, adults, and seniors at each of 3 monthly pantry days.

You can help in three ways:

- Use your King Soopers card: Go online and designate our church to receive Community Rewards funds. We will receive a percentage of what you spend.
- Pick up an Albertsons/Safeway Community Giving card from Mission Ministry: Load it with up to \$500 and use the card when you buy groceries. We will receive up to 3% of what you spend.
- Write a check to First Presbyterian and put "Moorcroft Food Pantry" in the memo line.

Examples of need:

A truck driver severely injured, not earning a wage, and fighting Workers Comp and the insurance company, had no money to buy food for his family.

A woman who escaped domestic violence but had no money or food.

A shut-in whose monthly disability check could not cover enough food for the month as well as rent, utilities, etc.
