General Provisions

- a. The scholarship monies total approximately \$3,000.00 per year, and will be divided among those applicants whom the Scholarship Committee deems deserving.
- b. Half of the scholarship will be paid for the fall semester. The second half will be paid for the spring semester upon receipt of a copy of the student's transcript from the fall semester indicating at least a 2.5 grade point average earned.
- c. Previous scholarship holders may reapply, but such applicants will be considered with the other applicants without a preference.
- d. The award will be announced at a date determined by the Scholarship Committee.

2. Eligibility

- The applicant must be a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Cheyenne, Wyoming.
- b. The applicant must comply with the admission requirements set forth by the college for which the scholarship will be used.
- c. The applicant may be of any age, but must be a full-time undergraduate student.

3. Application Procedure

- a. An application form with supporting documents must be provided by the Scholarship Committee and must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee, First Presbyterian Church, 220 W. 22nd Street, Cheyenne, WY 82001, no later than March 1 of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

KEITH WEIGNER MEMORIAL HEALTH CARE SCHOLARSHIP

1. General Provisions

- a. If monies are available, the award is \$500 per semester and may be extended for a second semester if the student furnishes evidence of academic achievement to the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship award available per student will be two semesters for a total of \$1,000.
- b. Recipient must attend an accredited, post-secondary school.
- c. Recipient of the scholarship award will be determined by the Scholarship Committee of the Christian Education Ministry.
- d. An award winner will be recognized as determined by the Scholarship Committee.
- e. The Scholarship award does not have to be awarded in any given year or subsequent semester as deemed appropriate by the Scholarship Committee.

2. Eligibility

- a. The first consideration of this award is the financial need of the applicant.
- b. Each applicant is required to demonstrate a likelihood of successful completion of a healthcare related education and entry into a healthcare occupation.
- c. An applicant must be a member of a local Presbyterian Church First, Highlands, Burns, or Korean.

3. Application Procedures

- a. An application with supporting documents must be provided by the Scholarship Committee and must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee, First Presbyterian Church, 220 W. 22nd Street, Cheyenne, WY 82001, no later than March 1 of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
