COMEA has purchased a property that will be transformed into a shelter for homeless families. It will be known as the Journey Center and will have four bedrooms, a shared kitchen, TV room/dining room, laundry facilities, bathroom with showers and outdoor play area.

A nationally known TV show “The Fixers” will be in Cheyenne October 25-31 to complete this facility. They will need local volunteers to accomplish this effort.

They need both skilled and unskilled volunteers and the work tasks include demolishing, framing, flooring, dry wall, finishing details, painting and electrical and plumbing.

They will organize work groups each day from the community as signups are received for shifts (8:00AM-1:00) and 1:30PM -6:30PM. Lunch will be provided as well as drinks and snacks during the day.

All participants will be required to be COVID tested and this will be free from the Laramie County Health Office at 100 Central Avenue by 10/16 or at the site by medical staff.
