Beginning the third week of May, we will take reservations for June. You will be able to make your reservations for the entire month at one time. Day of Giving

Food and Personal Hygiene will be collected through May 9. The most needed items are any nonperishable food you enjoy eating and any hygiene items you use when you get ready for work would be great. Protein sources such as canned tuna, peanut butter, and dried beans are very important; Hamburger Helper or the generic equivalent makes it easy to create a meal; canned fruits and vegetables and tomato products are important staples.

For hygiene items: laundry detergent is a hygiene item and very much appreciated by agencies like Safehouse, Boys & Girls Club, and the hygiene closet at Salvation Army. For kids in upper elementary school and older: deodorant, shaving cream, razors, and feminine hygiene products. Individually wrapped toothbrushes and toothpaste, body wash or bar soap, shampoo and conditioner, are essential.
